

## Rules and Procedures for the Kite Aerial Photography Member's Choice Annual Competition

AKA members in attendance at the convention will vote on their favorite aerial images, and an award will be given for the image with the most votes.

## **Entry Guidelines**

Each photo entered in the competition must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Photographs submitted must have been taken by the contestant.
- 2. Photographs submitted must have been made by lifting a camera with a kite.
- 3. The photographer must be a member in good standing of AKA at the time of the convention.
- 4. Images that have received awards in any other competition are not eligible.
- 5. Images must be submitted as prints & mounted on matte board. There are no size limitations, but keep in mind that display space will be limited, and/or may be horizontal, e.g., flat on a table.
- 6. No signature, title, name, or explanatory text may appear on the face of the mounted print.

Up to three images may be submitted by each member.

It is *not* necessary that the member be in attendance at the AKA convention.

## **Submitting an Entry**

An information sheet must accompany each submission, containing:

- 1. Image title
- 2. Photographer's name and address
- 3. Image location
- 4. Month and year image was taken
- 5. Medium (digital or film)
- 6. Make of camera and kite
- 7. A brief description of any manipulation of the finished image

Additionally, although not required, the AKA requests a digital copy of each entry and permission to reproduce each image in AKA publications.
